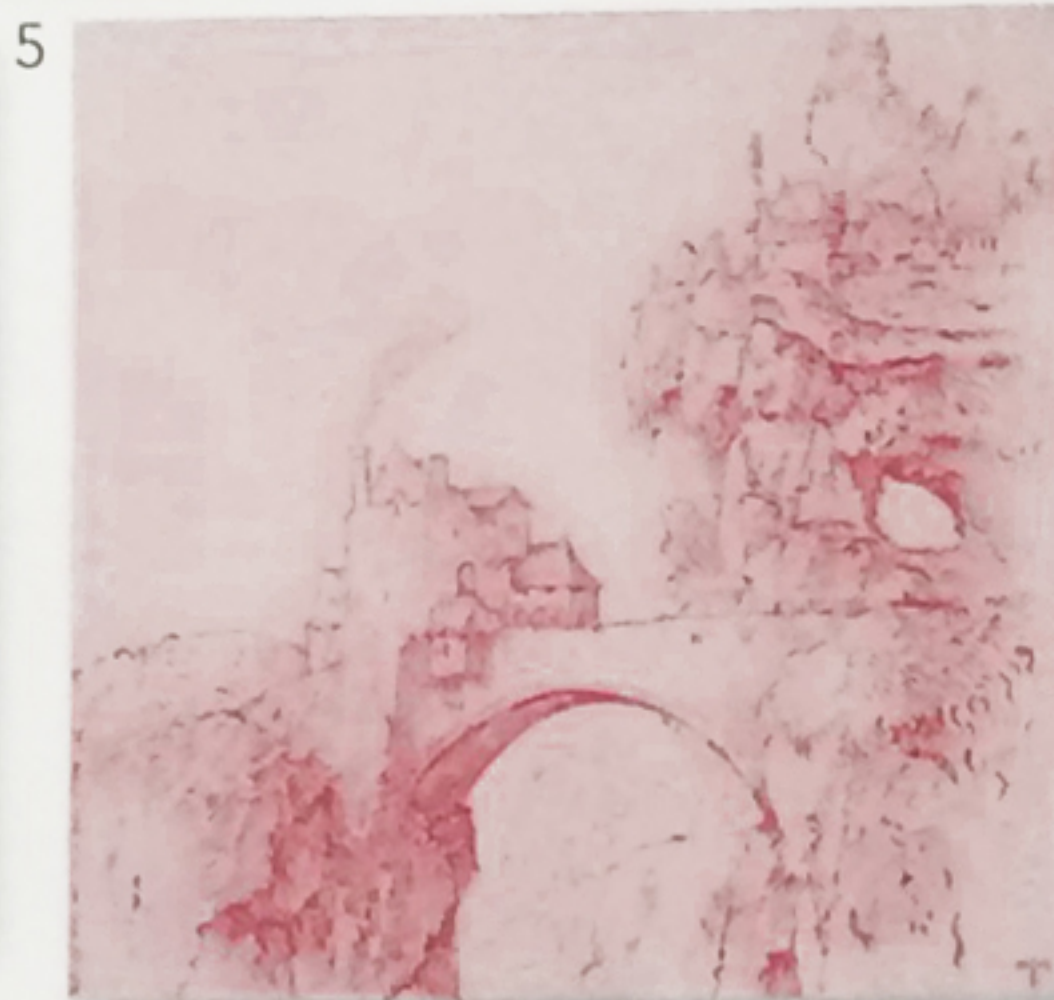


In the Pink
